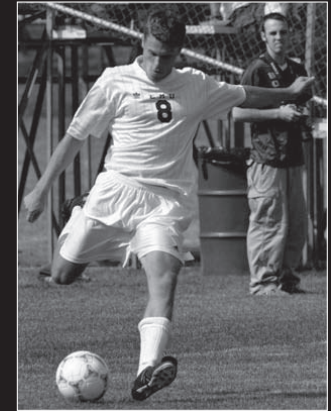

**Health/safety:** Each participant must have a medical statement and release signed by a parent or guardian stating that he/she is in good health and able to participate. Any illness or injury will be handled by EMU athletic trainers and staff.

**Insurance:** All campers must have insurance. If a participant does not have his/her own medical coverage, he/she cannot attend camp.

**Rules and regulations:** Participants must abide by the rules and regulations of Eastern Michigan University. Campers are required to attend all sessions and activities. Any individual who does not abide by the rules and regulations will be dismissed from camp. Their money will not be refunded.

**Living accommodations:** The EMU student residence halls will again be the home for the EMU Sports Camps. All campers will be supervised by coaches, counselors and EMU staff, day and night.

**Registration:** Will be on Sunday afternoon at the residence hall for resident and commuter campers, unless otherwise specified. Confirmation materials will include official registration times and a specific residence hall.

**Recreation activities:** The multi-million-dollar Lloyd W. Olds Student Recreation Center will be available to campers. The facility features a beautiful indoor/outdoor swimming complex, basketball and racquetball courts, snack bar and more.
